1) Bottar Leone Scholarship - \$2,500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: July 1, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) In academic "good standing" with a high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0+ on a 4-point scale (or equivalent);

B) Documented physical or learning disability (students with ADD/ADHD alone are not eligible); and

MJFLA is a nonsectarian, nonprofit organization that offers interest-free loans up to \$5,000 per year to help students and their families afford the rising cost of higher education. **Every student who has filled out a FAFSA should also be applying for this loan.** Cosigners are required and repayment begins while in school (low monthly payments of \$100/mo.)

The [Gates Millennium Scholarship](#) covers unmet financial need for African American, American Indian, Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American, and Hispanic American students. You need to have a GPA of at least 3.3, along with a commitment to service and leadership.

To win the Gates Millennium Scholarship, your school needs to nominate you. You also need to answer several essay questions. If you think you could qualify, speak to a teacher, counselor, or your principal about next steps

The [Intel Science Search](#) is a national contest for aspiring scientists and mathematicians. Before winning scholarship money, you have participated in a long-term research project. Projects could be in computer science, environmental science,

engineering, or biochemistry, among other fields. The Intel Foundation [awards one winner](#) with \$75,000 and other finalists with scholarships of varying amounts.

This [merit-based scholarship](#) goes to high-achieving students with financial need. The selection process is similar to the college admissions process. The scholarship committee looks at your grades, test scores, extracurriculars, essays, and recommendation letters. Winners get up to \$40,000 each year for tuition, books, room, board, and other fees.

[Microsoft](#) awards a variety of scholarships, some of which cover the full cost of tuition. To qualify, you must plan to study computer science, science, technology, engineering, or math. Winners have a strong academic and extracurricular background, along with demonstrated financial need.

The [Siemens Competition](#) is another national contest for budding scientists and mathematicians. After a long-term research project, finalists win between \$1,000 and \$100,000 for tuition. Students can work individually or in groups of two or three. Projects cover a range of scientific fields, but most are devoted to solving global problems.

This [full-tuition scholarship](#) goes to aspiring STEM students who are interested in a career in national defense. Winners are expected to do a summer internship and work for a period as a Department of Defense civilian. The scholarship also includes a healthy stipend, health insurance, mentoring, and a [yearly allowance](#) of \$1,000 for miscellaneous supplies.

The United States Department of Scholarship offers [this full-tuition scholarship](#) to students planning to attend one of the [1890 historically black land-grant universities](#), like Alabama A&M University or Tennessee State University. Winners have a record of leadership, plus they plan to study food, agriculture, natural resource science, or a related discipline. USDA scholars get summer jobs and potential employment with the USDA after graduation.

The requirements for a \$100,000 [Dr. Pepper scholarship](#) are unique. First, you need to post your goal to change the world on Facebook. If you get 50 likes, then you make a short video. A committee reviews all the videos, and winners receive prizes anywhere from [\\$2,500 to \\$100,000](#) for tuition.

A **TIP Grant** of \$1,000 is available for students who are first time college freshman, Wisconsin residents attending a Wisconsin college and meet financial need and other guidelines. Stop by Student Services for scholarship application or call 414-227-4466
