**Local Community Scholarships**

**Deadline: Friday, April 7, 2017 at 3pm**

**Aurora Medical Center Grafton**

- Criteria:
1. Recipient must be a graduating senior pursuing a degree in health sciences at a 4- year post-secondary school.
  2. Recipient must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0
  3. The amount awarded will be \$1000 upon proof of college acceptance, class registration and tuition deposit.
  4. Applications must be submitted to the Nicolet Student Services Office (C105) no later than Friday, April 7, 2017.

**Brittney Gigl Memorial Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Graduating senior
  2. Have maintained a "B" average or better.
  3. Involved in extracurricular activities, community service or fine arts.
  4. Be a recognized leader as demonstrated by involvement in and helping others in school,

Award: One award of at least \$1,000

**Janet Schmitz O'Hara Award for Volunteerism**

- Criteria:
1. Student has demonstrated active volunteer service in the community, including help to others at school, in their neighborhood, at their worship, or wherever else they have lent a hand.
  2. Graduating senior who is accepted to a post secondary institution.
  3. Student should have at least a "C" average.

Award: One award of \$1,000

**The Kevin Cole Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Graduating senior who plans to go on for post high education of any kind.
  2. Have been involved in any of the fine arts programs at NHS. An emphasis on any aspect of theatre productions will be given added consideration for the award(s).
  3. Maintained a "C" average or better.

Award: At least one award of \$1,000

**Mason's Scholarship (James M. Hays Lodge)**

- Criteria :
1. Graduating senior from a Wisconsin High School, display a commendable academic record and the potential to successfully continue achievement in a post secondary college or university. This includes a Junior college or technical college when the full credit load is acceptable to a degree granting institution. The attending college may be public or private and the course of study must lead toward a baccalaureate or associate degree.
  2. The recipient will have demonstrated leadership ability and service as evidenced by school, community and church or synagogue involvement.

Award: One award in the amount of \$1,650

### **Nicolet High School Foundation Senior Volunteer Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Graduating senior who has been accepted to an institution of higher education.
  2. Maintained a "C" average through high school.
  3. Shall be able to demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism both in school and in the community.

Award: Award is \$500

### **Laura Miller Memorial Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Graduating senior.
  2. Interested in journalism, fashion/fine arts, politics and community service.
  3. Maintained a "B" average throughout high school.
  4. Possess outstanding character, exhibits leadership and academic excellence.

Award: Minimum of one award of \$1,000

### **NSUE Memorial Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Minimum "B" average
  2. Outstanding character
  3. Leadership qualities
  4. Commit to pursuing a career in education
  5. Completes an essay\*
  6. Provides a typewritten list of all schools in which the candidate attended K through 12.
  7. Lists community, school or employment activities the candidate may have been involved with during high school that has contributed to their goal of entering into the teaching profession.

Award: Scholarship of \$1,000

### **The Mel and Bette Wade Family Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. Pursuing a career in education, English, Journalism or business.
  2. Exhibits leadership and or volunteerism at Nicolet and/or community.
  3. Maintain a B average or better.
  4. Participate in a variety of extracurricular activities.
  5. Strong desire to help others.
  6. Graduating senior.

Award: One award of a minimum of \$500

### **WaterStone Bank Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. A graduating senior.
  2. Display a commendable academic record and pursuing a baccalaureate degree in an accredited college or university.
  3. Demonstrated leadership and service as evidenced by school and community involvement.
  4. Determination to set and reach goals and evidence the ability to overcome obstacles will be given consideration.

Award: One award of \$1,000

### **The John Harrington Memorial Scholarship**

- Criteria:
1. A graduating senior pursuing post-high classes or a degree in fire science or music, at an accredited institution.
  2. Display a strong work ethic through their high school career (as documented by references in the application).

Award: One or more scholarships, of a minimum of \$500 will be awarded to members of the 2016 graduating class.
