Students will be considered for Parking Tags on a first come first serve basis!

- **Parking applications may be submitted beginning July 11th**
- Please submit payment (\$400/year) in the form of CASH or a CHECK made out to *Nicolet High School*. Student may pick up parking tags in high school office the first week of school.
- **Parking tickets may be issued beginning September 12, 2016.**
- Parking Tags can be purchased in the high school office until all spots are sold out.
- **Parking Tags will NOT be issued before school. Student may submit application and payments before school, but the tags will be issued at lunch or after school.**
- You MUST have your Parking Tag visible in your car when parking in the high school lot, or you will be ticketed.

Student Parking and Driving Regulations

1. The parking fee is **\$100** per quarter. I understand that if I lose my parking tag for any reason, the **FEE is not refundable**.
2. If a student drives a different vehicle from the one attached to the parking tag, inform **Mrs. Couch** in the high school office. Failure to do so may result in a parking ticket.
3. **PARKING TAGS MUST BE VISIBLY DISPLAYED ON THE REAR VIEW MIRROR OR FRONT WINDSHIELD. THE VEHICLE WILL BE TICKETED IF THE PARKING TAG IS NOT DISPLAYED PROPERLY**
4. If students are parked illegally, a parking ticket will be issued for the first two offenses. For three offenses and beyond, the vehicle will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense. No further notification will be given.
5. Students who fail to comply with stated parking regulations will forfeit their privileges. **Causes for suspension or permanent loss of parking tags** may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Allowing someone else to use your parking tag.
 - b. Failure to comply with safe driving rules and regulations on campus and on adjacent streets.
 - c. Parking illegally, in the horseshoe, or No Parking Zones on Nicolet property.
 - d. Parking in Nicolet High School Faculty/Staff Lots.
 - e. Disciplinary action /Suspension(s) from school.
 - f. **Tardies** (unexcused):
 - 1) 1st offense – 5 or more tardies to 1st hour – loss of parking privileges for two weeks
 - 2) 2nd offense – 3 or more tardies to 1st hour – (beyond 1st offense) loss of parking privileges for one month
 - 3) 3rd offense – 1 or more tardies to 1st hour – (beyond 2nd offense) loss of parking privileges for remainder of semester
 - g. **Truancies**:
 - 1) 1st offense – 5 or more truancies, all or part of day – loss of parking privileges for two weeks
 - 2) 2nd offense – 3 or more truancies, all or part of day – (beyond 1st offense) loss of parking privileges for one month
 - 3) 3rd offense – 1 or more truancies, all or part of day – (beyond 2nd offense) loss of parking privileges for semester
6. School officials, including police liaison officers, may search any vehicle owned or operated by a student on school grounds at any time without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant if they have reasonable suspicion that there is evidence of a crime or infraction of a school rule or contraband in the vehicle.
7. There are no parking tags for 9th graders.
8. You **do not** need a parking tag to park at Nicolet during final exam week. Having a parking tag during the semester **does not** guarantee you a parking spot during final exam week.

Keep in mind that parking on campus is a privilege, not a right.
