- Please submit payment (\$100/qtr \$200/semester \$400/year) in the form of CASH or a CHECK made out to *Nicolet High School*.
- **Parking tickets** may be issued beginning **September 11, 2017**.
- Students with a valid parking permit do not have an assigned parking spot; however, they must park in the student parking lot.
- Parking permits will NOT be issued before school. Student may submit application with payment before school, but permits will be issued at lunch or after school.

## Student Parking and Driving Regulations

1. The parking fee is **\$100** per quarter. I understand that if I lose my parking permit for any reason, the **FEE is not refundable**.
2. Parking fees are due prior to the beginning of each quarter. Failure to make payment can result in a parking ticket, loss of parking permit, or both.
3. If a student drives an alternate vehicle, the student is required register the vehicle at the front desk. Students **MUST** know the license plate number of any alternate vehicle driven, or they are subject to a ticket. Failure to report an alternate vehicle may result in a parking ticket.
4. **PARKING PERMITS ARE TO BE PLACED ON THE INSIDE OF THE REAR WINDOW IN THE LOWER LEFT HAND CORNER. THE VEHICLE WILL BE TICKETED IF THE PARKING PERMIT IS NOT DISPLAYED PROPERLY.** The permits are not to be taped.



5. A parking ticket will be issued for the first two parking offenses. For three offenses and beyond, the vehicle will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense. No further notification will be given.
6. The authorization to drive and park a vehicle on school property is a **privilege**. The privilege may be withdrawn or suspended without refund **at any time**, and such a decision is solely the prerogative of school administration. The following will be considered a violation of regulations:
  - a. Careless operation of a vehicle.
  - b. Excessive speed.
  - c. Non-registered vehicles.
  - d. Parking in other than assigned parking areas.
  - e. Improper placement of permit.
  - f. Parking in Nicolet High School Faculty/Staff Lots.
  - g. Use of a registered vehicle in the violation of school policy and procedures.
  - h. Use of cars to promote skipping and/or transportation of truant students.
  - i. Disciplinary action/suspension from school.
  - j. Tardiness: Student is chronically tardy to school. The minimum amount of time that a permit will be revoked for is two weeks.
  - k. Truancy: Student is truant for all or part of a day, three (3) or more times. The minimum amount of time that a permit will be revoked for is two weeks.
7. School officials, including police liaison officers, may search any vehicle owned or operated by a student on school grounds at any time without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant if they have reasonable suspicion that there is evidence of a crime or infraction of a school rule or contraband in the vehicle.
8. There are no parking permits for 9<sup>th</sup> graders.
9. You **do not** need a parking permit to park at Nicolet during final exam week. Having a parking permit during the semester **does not** guarantee you a parking spot during final exam week.

**Remember that parking on campus is a privilege, not a right.**
