PAC Meeting Notes

March 10, 2020

1. Finance Update

- Budget and recent expenses were reviewed. End of year projected balance is about \$15,300, an increase of \$2,800 over the beginning of the year.
- Unpaid bills from program ads were reviewed. After receiving invoices in February Lakeshore Family Dentistry and Town & Country Building Inspection remain unpaid and will be removed from all future programs. Just Drive paid their invoice.

2. Music and Theater

- **Angela** and **Loretta** met to discuss the options for decreasing cost and effort to produce the insert and program for the theater shows and the insert for other performing arts events. A recommendation has been agreed on, pending a follow up conversation with the printer to clarify costs. It will be shared with the committee and Ms. Anderle before the end of the school year.
- Little Shop overview
 - Ticket sales process went relatively smoothly. Student ticket sales were improved over past experience. Last minute arrivals did put some strain on both sales and lines to enter. **Karen** or **Rick** can provide more information at a future meeting.
 - Cast, crew and pit meals went smoothly, the standard work has been updated regarding quantities of food purchased.

3. From Prior Meetings

- Kenn Miller chair preparation - the PAC is starting to think about fundraising for the Kenn Miller chair in the 2021-2022 school year. **Loretta** will reach out to the arts teachers to determine if they have any thoughts about an artist yet.
- Middle school outreach is on hold given current school closures. Parent 101 that includes parent committees was scheduled for 3/18, we will participate when/if it is rescheduled. Ideas for outreach to middle schools can be implemented if school resumes this year, or in the next school year.

- Graphic design - **Angela** will reach out to Mr. Dicks to determine if student help with the inserts might be available next school year.

4. New Items

- End of year teacher gifts - if school does not resume **Loretta** will discuss with the committee electronically.
- Ad sales - the committee would like to have a volunteer in place by June to coordinate this process for the 2020-21 school year. **Loretta** will follow up.
