Fan Conduct

The WIAA rules will be strictly enforced by the event and facility staff:

- Cheer and remarks that attack a team, a player, a coach, a school or a referee **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- Noisemakers, sound systems, air horns and confetti are not allowed.
- Signs able to be held by one person are allowed. Keep the signs small!
- Body paint is only allowed on faces. Body paint must be removed or the body part covered with clothing or the individual will not be allowed to enter or stay in the Kohl Center.
- Shirts must be worn at all times. Inappropriate attire will not be allowed.
- **No spectators are allowed on the court after the game (citations may be issued).**
- **For the safety and security of all patrons, certain items may not be brought into the Kohl Center. This includes but is not limited to: any food or beverage items, cans, bottles, coolers, thermoses, backpacks, large bags (gym, duffel, and tote), luggage, strollers, laser pointers, banners, flags, signs, noisemakers, weapons, balloons, or beach balls. All patrons entering the Kohl Center are subject to search. Storage facilities are not available for checking prohibited items.**

State Basketball Tournament Information for Students and Families

FRIDAY MARCH 15 **All students attend school periods 1-4**

Option 1: Student Riding a Fan Bus

1. Student turns in a signed permission slip from a parent/guardian, purchases a ticket at Nicolet (\$10) and reserves a spot on a bus by Friday, March 15 at 9:00am.
2. Fan buses load at 10:30 am and depart Nicolet by 10:45 am. **NO BAGS OR BACKPACKS ALLOWED ON THE BUS.**
3. Fan buses return to Nicolet between 6:00-7:00pm.

ATTENDANCE: Students will be **EXCUSED** by Nicolet for a Field Trip.

Option 2: Student Driving or Riding With a Parent/Guardian

1. Student purchases a ticket for the game (\$10).
2. Parent/guardian calls the attendance office and excuses the student from school.

ATTENDANCE: Parents must excuse their son/daughter by calling 414-351-8282 or emailing: attendance@nicolet.us Students will be marked **EXCUSED**.

Option 3: Student Remains at School

1. Students attend regular classes periods 1-4.
2. Periods 5-8, students will report to their regular class. If their teacher is not available, students should report to another classroom to receive support in that subject area. A list of available teachers will be posted on classroom doors. **ALL CONTENT AREAS WILL HAVE TEACHERS AVAILABLE FOR ACADEMIC SUPPORT.**
3. Nicolet Food Service will still be serving lunch during regularly scheduled lunch periods.

ATTENDANCE: Students will be marked **PRESENT** by scanning in the classroom.

SATURDAY MARCH 16 (If Nicolet wins on Friday)

Students sign up for the fan bus Friday night on the way back to Nicolet

Option 1: Students Riding Fan Bus

1. Student turns in (or has turned in) a signed permission slip from a parent/guardian and purchases a game ticket at the Kohl Center Friday after the game. (please remember to bring \$10 cash for Saturday's ticket).
2. Student arrives at Nicolet by 3:30pm.
3. Fan buses load at 3:30pm and depart by 3:45pm.
4. Fan buses return to Nicolet at approximately 10:30pm.

Option 2: Students Driving, Riding With a Parent/Guardian, or Staying in Madison

1. Student purchases a ticket for the game (\$10) at the Kohl Center Friday after the game. (please remember to bring \$10 cash for Saturday's ticket).

Students are responsible for their own lunch/dinner.

Saturday, March 16 (if Nicolet wins Friday)

Game tickets will be available for purchase (\$10) at the Kohl Center immediately following the game Friday. (Please bring \$10 cash for Saturday's ticket). **Bus transportation can be reserved after the game Friday on the bus ride back to Nicolet.** Please plan accordingly. Students riding the bus will receive their game ticket as they **exit** the bus in Madison. Students are responsible for their own lunch/dinner.
